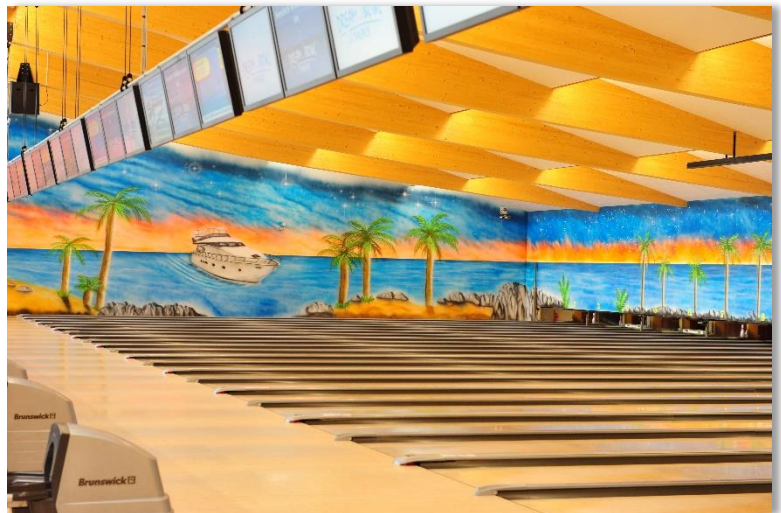




Competition Venue

Participants of some countries will have to apply for visa.

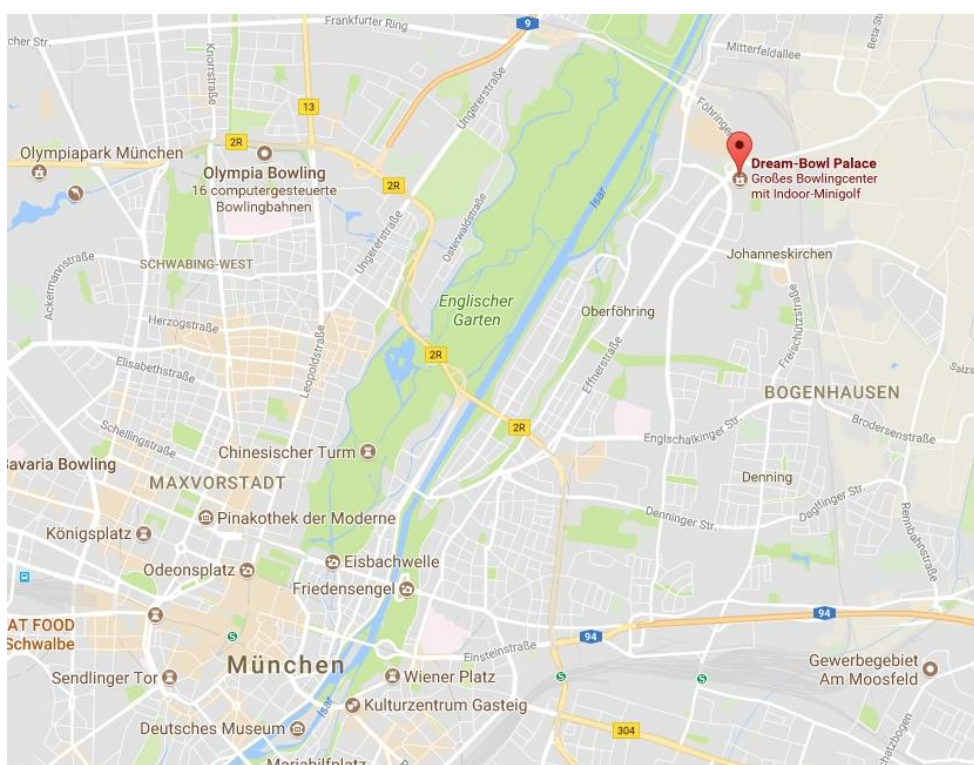
Please provide us with the following information as soon as possible:
